EDUCATIONAL IMPROVEMENT Organization

Schreiber Center for Pediatric Development is an approved Educational Improvement Organization (EIO). We partner with Lancaster County-based high schools to provide supplemental learning opportunities in childcare (CC), human services (HS) and disability inclusion (DI). Throughout the year, students may participate in the following activities:

Activity	Learning Category	Description
Circle of Friends Academy	CC, HS, DI	Our inclusive childcare program operates 7:30 am to 5:30 pm, Monday – Friday and has infant, toddler and preschool classrooms.
S.T.A.R.S. Preschool	CC, HS, DI	A year-round preschool open to all children ages 3 – 5. The preschool is licensed by the State Board of Academic Schools, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and focuses on reverse-mainstreaming, an approach that includes children of all abilities learning together to develop understanding, acceptance, and value diversity.
Respite	HS, DI	Offered six times per year (three in the fall and three in the spring) on a Friday evening, respite nights provide an outlet for parent/guardians to step away from their child for an evening knowing they're being cared for and entertained in a safe and inclusive environment.
Club 625	HS, DI	Throughout the year, Club 625 brings together Schreiber teens and young adults to gather and participate in activities including an Halloween Party, St. Paddy's Day Dance, dinner and a movie, etc. Club 625 also offers a 1-2 week field-trip camp in August working on social skills in the community.
Camp Schreiber	HS, DI	Hosted for five weeks (June – July) each summer, Camp Schreiber is a day camp held, M-Th. Volunteers, counselors and Schreiber clients enjoy daily activities in a safe and inclusive environment.
