Our mission is to enrich the lives of children with disabilities, developmental delays, and acquired injuries through family-centered education and therapy.


## **Therapy Highlights**

In FY25, our therapists provided:


- 12,914 hours of occupational therapy (OT)

- 8,851 hours of speechlanguage therapy (SLT)



Family Support Programs - We understand that raising a child with special needs can be both rewarding and challenging. We offered caretakers six evenings of respite, providing care to 138 children and more importantly providing parents and caregivers with a well-deserved break.



**Independent Activities of Daily Living -**

18 teens completed a twelve-week cohort designed to teach activities of daily living aimed at boosting confidence, developing social skills and preparing for education and workforce transitions.
